Healthy School

Dress Code

Blouses with spaghetti straps and shorts and skirts shorter than the arm and hand extended along the body are not acceptable outfits to school. For boys, shirts without sleeves and shorts that are too short are not part of the dress code. For rainy days, a raincoat and rubber boots are a must.

Also, we discourage students from wearing sandals, "flip flop" and walk barefoot in the school. There are physical activity classes each day and sandals are not acceptable shoes for this type of activity. We ask students to wear closed shoes to provide better security and participation in all activities.
