Homework

The purpose of homework is to practice the concepts that have been taught in class and to develop good individual work habits. The student is responsible for handing in his work and homework on time. If the student cannot do his work for a valid reason, the student must bring a note written by his parents to explain why. We all recognize that family lives are very busy and that sometimes it is difficult to complete the homework for a specific time. According to our school board policies, here is a time guide for homework at home:

Grade 1 to 3: 3 sessions per week, each lasting between 15 to 30 min.

Grade 4 to 6 : 2-4 sessions per week , each lasting between 30 to 45 minutes .

If you exceed this time regularly, please contact your child teacher.

Head Lice

At school, students are in close contact. This provides ideal conditions for the spread of head lice. When your child has head lice, we do not prevent him/her from coming to school. However, it is important to notify the school and give your child the necessary treatment. Once treated, please check and remove the eggs manually every day for a period of at least two weeks.
