#### Insect repellent and sunscreen

We would like to advise you of the following Alberta Health Services recommendations for parents on the use of insect repellent and sunscreen lotion:

- Apply bug spray prior to children leaving for school.
- Send long pants and long-sleeved jackets with your child as it is much better for students to cover up when they are outside, rather than using bug spray.
- Be advised that the peak eating times for mosquitoes are dawn and dusk and these times are not during school hours, so by covering up, children should be okay outside.
- Staff members will not apply insect repellent on students.
- Should parents send insect repellent with their child for a field trip, please advise your child that for safety precautions, this insect repellent is not to be shared with other students. Depending on the age of the child, the school may want to store the insect repellent in a safe spot in the classroom.
- If insect repellent is sent to school for a field trip, it should only be sprayed outside, away from other students.

#### Dress Code

Remember that spaghetti straps and shorts and skirts that are above the extended arm and hand are not permitted at school. Boys are not permitted muscle shirts. We strongly recommend wearing a hat on sunny days and rubber boots and a raincoat are a must for rainy days.
