Dear Parent/Legal Guardian of grade one students,

As your child is attending grade one, this is an ideal time to review your child's immunization history to ensure they are up to date on their immunizations. It is important to keep your child's immunizations up to date in order to prevent disease and to help keep them healthy. The routine recommended schedule of vaccines for Alberta can be found at <https://www.alberta.ca/immunization-routine-schedule.aspx>

Preschool immunizations are complete once your child has:

- A booster dose (given after age 4) of Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis/Polio vaccine
- A second dose of MMRV (measles mumps, rubella, and varicella) vaccine

These immunizations are provided free of charge.

If you are new to Alberta OR if your child has been immunized at your doctor's office, pharmacy or private travel clinic, Primary Care Alberta may not have a complete record of your child's immunizations. Immunization records can be submitted via email to: edm.ph.records.sta@primarycarealberta.ca
