Dear Parent/Legal Guardian of pre-kindergarten or kindergarten students,

As you plan for your child to attend kindergarten, or if they are already in kindergarten, this is an ideal time to review your child's immunization history to ensure they are up to date on their immunizations. It is important to keep your child's immunizations up to date in order to prevent disease and to help keep them healthy. Children are due for the following routine vaccine at 4 years of age:

- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis/Polio

This immunization is provided free of charge.
